The Shop's journey began a little over a year ago, when its foundation and walls were poured in preparation for the moving North House's timbered, open-air blacksmithing shed.

Fall brought the flying of the frame (via enormous crane), and over the winter walls, porch, side additions and doors appeared.

In early spring chimneys sprouted from the structure, followed quickly with the installation of windows. April's Service Learning students pitched in to create the side draft forge hoods, the same week our first ton of coal arrived!

Celebrate and dedicate with us! The 2012 Wooden Boat Show will include the official blacksmith shop, dedication, complete with a boat-load of pie. Listen—already you can hear the hammer's song!
